

The challenge of Wagyu breeders and producers will be to present our breed as a legitimate breed within the industry, and not viewed as simply a niche market. The commercial industry also needs to be educated to the fact that the largest value of Wagyu is meat quality, and not to be judged on phenotype. However, the Wagyu breed, as a whole, will need to continually push for shorter feed periods and better feed conversions while maintaining excellent carcass qualities to make inroads into the commercial sector. The high-end fullblood market may not feel the squeeze in these areas, but they are still of great economic impact in any Wagyu program, small or large.

We are fortunate to be breeding Wagyu cattle in America. Our own domestic customer base is extremely large. This gives us the added opportunity to be able to market at "home" and not have to rely on export markets as many other beef producing countries must do. America is experiencing a great demand for higher quality beef, from Prime to Prime +, and has the financial means to purchase better beef. The health benefits of Wagyu serve as an added bonus to the consumer's eating experience. There are tremendous opportunities such as direct marketing, on-line marketing, restaurant sales, wholesale distributors, and export markets to participate in to impact the profitability of Wagyu breeding and feeding programs. A thriving and diverse beef market will ultimately drive the genetics side of the Wagyu industry. We hope that wherever you are in the Wagyu business, large or small, new or established, that you will find this conference to be a valuable resource.



ANTHONY WINTER

Manager, Macquarie Wagyu

A cropping, breeding, and feedlotting operation in Queensland, Australia. Macquarie runs about a 700 head Fullblood cow herd with backgrounding capacity and a 2,900 head feedlot capacity. The feedlot feeds Fullbloods for 500 days and 400 days for F1s. Macquarie Wagyu is a world leader in Wagyu breeding stock, having bred high ranking sires such as Macquarie Prelude M0495, Macquarie Wagyu C1176, and Macquarie Wagyu Y408.

NICK HAMMETT

KERWEE

Marketing Manager, Circle A Angus Ranch

Circle A Angus is a 7,000 head Angus herd in Missouri. Circle A has been using Wagyu genetics from top carcass traits proven Wagyu sires for 10 yrs now to increase



overall profitability. Reaching 70 - 80% Prime on 1/4th blood steers, while also taking them to heavier weights with better yield. Circle A estimates they are making \$300 more on Wagyu cross steers. Circle A has thousands of head worth of carcass data and are confident that the system has the potential to add real value for commercial cattlemen.

STEVE MARTIN

General Manager of Operation, Kerwee Feedlot

Located in Australia, Kerwee has a 20,000 head capacity, with 15,000 Wagyu content animals. Kerwee feeds cattle for 400 days and markets into their own branded beef line Stockyard Beef. Stockyard Beef recently won the Wagyu content/percentage category in the Triple Crown Steak challenge at Purdue University. Steve continues to make efforts to share data and develop value-based marketing options by using Feed Efficiency testing and the Wagyu Sire Progeny Test Program. Steve has run the Australian Wagyu Association's Wagyu Sire Progeny Test Program at Kerwee Feedlot.

Trent Bridge is a family owned and operated Fullblood and F1 Wagyu operation in New South Wales, Australia. Trent Bridge runs approximately 300 Fullblood cows and 300 Angus cows. They target the F1 market, selling approximately 60 Fullblood bulls for F1 produc-

tion each year. In addition, they use their top Fullblood sires on their commercial Angus herd for F1 production, selling the resulting calves at approximately 330 kg after weaning to JBS who feeds them for 400 days and slaughters them. Trent Bridge has become a leading breeding stock producer having bred and sold Trent Bridge K0034 the second-highest selling animal in the 2019 Elite Wagyu Sale at \$200,000.

JOJO CARRALES

Vice President, HeartBrand Beef

eart Bra HeartBrand Beef is a Texas based operation structured around the Akaushi or Red Wagyu breed of cattle. They focus on utilizing Akaushi genetics to produce a consistent, high quality and marbled beef product. Akaushi genetics have allowed HeartBrand to achieve 95% Choice or Prime on their F1 cattle. HeartBrand markets approximately 350 Akaushi bulls each year to commercial cattleman.







Importance of Maternal Lines


There is an art to breeding cattle. Despite the scientific advances that have been made with EBVs, EPDs, performance tests, DNA tests, and the rise of genomics, breeders still do not control or understand everything that occurs in breeding and genetics. An example of these uncontrollable and sometimes unexplainable interactions is how specific maternal lines exhibit superior traits in an area consistently from generation to generation (and weaknesses in the same pattern). The demonstration of superior traits by specific maternal lines whether it be for marbling, milk, growth, etc. occurs despite varying sire combinations and the breeder's best attempts at balanced or corrective breeding.



Value of an Elite Female

Record prices have been recorded for elite Wagyu females in both the USA and Australia over the last three years. What has led to this point can be described as a "perfect storm" due to a variety of different factors. A combination of advances in reproductive technology, increased accuracy of GEBVs, an increased emphasis on key profitability traits, more readily available semen of elite sires, a boom in industry entrants, and an ever expanding global demand for premium marbled beef were all key players in developing the market for elite Wagyu females and genetics. With advances in both conventional embryo transfer (ET) and in vitro fertilization (IVF), it is now routinely possible to produce 20 or more calves from a single donor in a year. When a single donor has the potential to produce more calves in a year, her value increases significantly. This, coupled with an increased emphasis on making genetic progress and selecting only high genetic merit females, has driven female value up. This is especially true for those with high EBVs and GEBVs. GEBVs have increased the reliability of EBVs significantly due to the addition of genomic SNP based testing through the Australian Wagyu Association. The increase in reliability has allowed breeders to more confidently select high potential females to invest time, money, and genetic resources into for producing their next generation of cattle.

A larger emphasis on key profitability traits such as marble score, eye muscle area, and hot carcass weight has been a key factor driving the increased prices for elite animals in the Wagyu breed. After having established a Wagyu herd and program many breeders are now searching for higher genetic merit animals to increase profitability and consistency. The emphasis on key production traits along

with the release of new elite and highly proven genetics such as Mayura Station's Mayura Itoshigenami JNR and Macquarie Wagyu's Coates Itoshigenami G113 gives breeders a source of superior genetics to pursue for improving their own Wagyu herds. The increased availability of semen from a variety of sires with superior EBVs to foundation sires gives breeders more reason to invest in premium donors. The key to producing your next great sire is in your females, as many breeders would say. Breeders who invest in premium females are then able to take full advantage of the advanced IVF and ET programs of today using next generation superior sires. This will assist breeders to rapidly increase the genetic merit of their animals.

Making genetic progress in traits such as Marble Score will result in increased profitability and in many cases a single Marble Score can be worth as much as \$400 per carcass. Therefore, a program harvesting 100 carcasses per year could see \$400 more revenue for each of its 100 carcasses and an overall revenue increase of \$40,000. Elite females have the ability to produce sires that can have these dramatic impacts on herd profit and is a major reason elite females are commanding top dollar.

The Wagyu breed and genetics market is driven either directly or indirectly by the ever-increasing global demand for premium marbled beef. High marbling and superior carcass traits are the hall-mark of the Wagyu breed and continues to bring new entrants into the Wagyu industry through a shared passion for high quality beef. In a pursuit to develop their own businesses or improve upon existing ones, new breeders are seeking high genetic value females to be the foundation of their programs.

EBV'S ...

As mentioned in the introduction for the catalog, the Australian EBVs and the WSU EPDs are key tools for Wagyu breeders seeking to make informed breeding decisions. Here we have included a few tables showcasing this data. EBVs/EPDs are an integral part of any breed looking to make steady genetic progress because they allow for the comparison of animals across different production systems and times through genetic linkage and herdmate deviations. EBVs/EPDs are especially useful in highlighting the strengths and weaknesses of cattle numerically, allowing for easier management and mating. The Australian Breedplan system has become the largest Wagyu EBV/EPD database outside of

Japan with more than 84,000 dams and 10,000 sires recorded, 6,700 AUS Meat Marble Score recorded, 5,800 Carcass Camera recorded carcasses (MS, MF, REA), 28,000 Weaning/200 Day Wts, and 24,000 400 Day Wts. Breedplan now offers genomic testing based on all this data for traits including MS, MF, CW, REA, 200D Wt, 400D Wt, 600D Wt, and more. This genomic testing is 50K SNP profile based genomics (Cattle Industry Leading Technology) which has been able to push the accuracy of EBVs higher yet. 
